Abstract:

Being a part of a mobile ad hoc community means no configuration hassle at all. It allows users to offer services to a community and of course to use such services. The devices can find themselves through different near field technologies like Bluetooth or W-LAN and build a temporary network by their own. Just as well they can look for specific services they need and can use them by using a common language.

The first part of this talk will inform you about our work of bringing an ad hoc networking via Bluetooth to mobile devices.

The second part is mainly focussed on offering, finding and consuming services like file sharing with different ad hoc technologies (Universal Plug and Play, Web Services) on mobile devices.

The Talk will be given in English.
